TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE 2021 - 2022

Lower Division K-2 Tuition - \$7,000 per year

New Student Fee - \$125 This is a one-time non-refundable fee. Due with application

Enrollment - \$225 Discounted to \$150 if before 7/26.

Installment

Available Tuition Discounts:

- **Payment in Full:**
 - Tuition paid in full will receive a 3% discount and tuition insurance will be waived.
- **Sibling Discounts:**
 - 2nd Child - - 10 % Discount on 2nd Child Tuition in Lower /Upper Division
 - 3rd + Child - - 20% Discount on 3rd+ Child Tuition

Tuition is payable in accordance with the terms outlined in the enrollment contract. Refunds of tuition or cancellation of unpaid charges will not be made upon absence, withdrawal, or dismissal.

BCA utilizes FACTS Management (FACTS), a tuition management company, to provide billing information to families. New families will receive an email invitation from FACTS to set up an account and select a payment plan and payment due dates. Current families will continue with their existing payment plan. Payment plans offered for 2021-22 include:

1. Payment in full by August 1, 2021
2. Payment of ½ tuition balance in August 2021 and ½ tuition balance in December 2021.
3. Payment of tuition balance over ten months from August 2021 through May 2022.

FACTS Administration Fee: FACTS charge \$20 for Annual and Semi-Annual plans and \$50 for monthly plans. This administration fee is paid directly to FACTS and will be drafted when your tuition amount is entered and finalized by the school.

FACTS Convenience Fee of 2.85% of the total tuition will be added by FACTS to cover credit card fees if paying tuition by credit card.
